

Update an Existing Channel

Updating a channel follows many of the same steps as submitting a new channel. On the **Developer Dashboard**, select **Manage My Channels** and select the channel that needs to be updated.

If none of the Properties or Channel Store Info needs to be updated, click on **Package Upload** to submit a new version.

On the **Package Upload** page, select:

- Channel Version
- Minimum firmware required to run the channel
- Application Package: Select signed package for publication

and then click on **Continue**.
